## **Transfer Student Requirements**

- 1 A minimum of half (50%) of business requirements must be completed in the College of Business at UA.
- 1 A minimum of 14 credit hours must be completed in the major at the College of Business.
- 1 ALL business transfer/ transient courses must be a "C" or better to receive credit.

- 1 Speech Requirement (7600/COMM:105 or 7600/COMM:106)
- 1 Algebra for Calculus (3450/MATH:145) or a higher-level Math
- 1 Principles of Microeconomics (3250/ECON:200) or Principles of Macroeconomics (3250/ECON:201)
- 1 Complete 1 of the following:

Accounting Principles I (6200/ACCT:201), or Spreadsheet Modeling & Decision Analysis (6200/ACCT:250), or Introduction to Entrepreneurship (6300/ENTRE:201), or Legal & Social Environment of Business (6400/FIN:220), or Marketing Principles (6600/MKTG:205)

If students are not admitted directly to a College of Business major, they are still welcome to participate in College of Business programs and activities as they work towards completing the above requirements.
